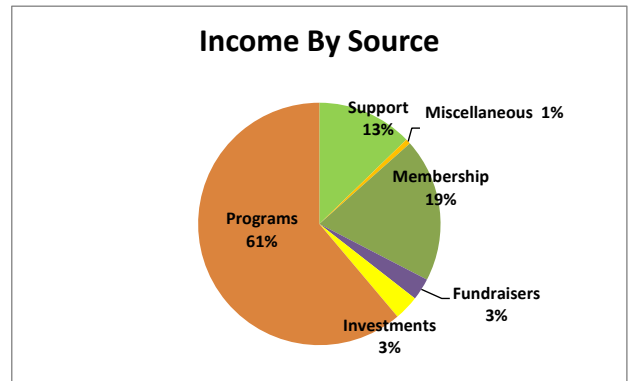

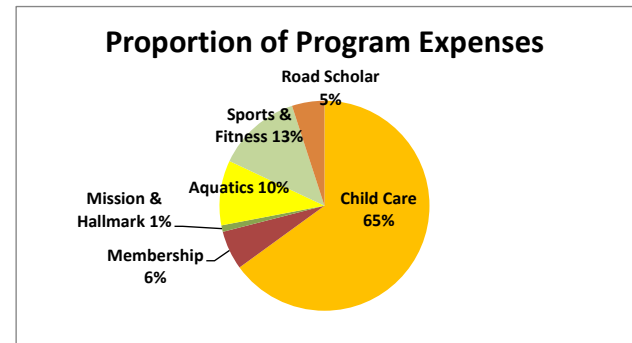

PRESERVING OUR LEGACY

YWCA Gettysburg & Adams County launched its \$900,000 endowment campaign in 2016.

Our membership and rec pass fees cover program expenses; however, ongoing repairs and upgrades to our 35-year-old building are costly. We are committed to controlling our operating expenses, and keeping our membership and program fees affordable for as many people in the community as we can. Raising rates enough to cover the looming costs of maintaining our aging building is an option we prefer not to face.

We have a wonderful building in a great location, and we want to maintain our YWCA for future generations. We can achieve this goal by improving our fiscal foundation and growing our endowment.

As of Nov. 13, 2018, we have raised \$750,552 in pledges, promises and payments.

We have received \$155,000 in legacy gifts.
