Thank you for choosing the YWCA and giving us the opportunity to help you sell your gently used children's clothing and other children's related items at our Nearly New Sale. The Sale occurs twice a year, Fall and Spring, and the proceeds from these sales help the YWCA of Gettysburg and Adams County raise funds for their programs. You also can make a little extra money yourself as well as help local families save money.

What to Bring for Your Nearly New Consignment

Seasonal Clothing for infants/ children up to 18 years: Fall and Winter clothes at the Fall Sale,

Spring and Summer clothes at the Spring Sale.

Please have your items "store-ready." Be sure everything has been washed, folded, and sorted by size.

Off-season items will be considered a donation to the YWCA.

Children's Shoes and Boots: Please secure them in pairs (boxed, tied together, or in a plastic bag)

Toys, Puzzles, Games, Books, Videos/DVD: Bring items complete and in good working condition

Baby Equipment that is clean, has all components, and is in good working condition.

Items determined to be unsellable will be placed on the free table outside of the gymnasium. Committee members make this decision.

As you begin to gather your items together, ask yourself, "Would I buy this for my child?"

We CANNOT Accept....

Underwear, boxers, bras, nursing bras, maternity clothing, baby equipment older than 3 years or that does not meet safety guidelines, car seats, crib bumper pads, stuffed animals, household items, and computer games (copyright issues).

Disregard of these guidelines may result in a \$10 Penalty against your Consignment Proceeds.

Consignment Checks Checks are usually mailed within 2 weeks from the conclusion of the sale. Please deposit or cash within 180 days. Checks that remain uncleared after 180 days will be forfeited and considered to be a donation by the YWCA (but will not be acknowledged in writing). If you do not wish for your items to be sold at the halfprice sale or the bag sale, you may claim unsold items between 5:00-6:00 p.m. on Friday. Items unsold at the conclusion of the bag sale will be donated to a local organization.
